Update – Civic Funeral for Officer Vincent Roy

Bromont, December 7, 2011 – The City of Bromont and the Bromont Police Service would like to inform you of the latest developments regarding the civic funeral to be held on December 9, 2011, at 2:00 p.m. for Officer Vincent Roy, who died in the line of duty on December 1.

Police officers forming the honour guard between the entrance hall of the Bromont arena and the St-François-Xavier church are to assemble at the arena, located at 20 John Savage Street.

Participants travelling by bus will be dropped off at the assembly point, where buses will be directed to a reserved parking area. All vehicles and police cars are to report to the SkiBromont P4 parking lot, that can be accessed using Vaudreuil Street (J2L 0A8), and located 1.4 kilometre from the assembly point, which can be safely walked in 10 minutes. A shuttle service may be available and remains to be confirmed.

The program as it stands is as follows:

- 11:00 a.m. Assembly
- 12:00 noon Forming of the honour guard
- 1:00 p.m. Funeral procession begins
- 2:00 p.m. Funeral service
- 3:30 p.m. End of ceremony

Those police officers who will not have access to the church due to limited seating will be seated at the Bromont arena, where they will be able to view the live broadcast of the funeral service.

Order of dress:

- Walking out order, where applicable
- Full uniform with long sleeves, collared sweater or tie, forage cap (no baseball-type cap) and full Sam Browne
- Full civilian attire is mandatory for all non-uniformed personnel

Groups of police officers belonging to the same organization will be formed.
